Work-based Learning and Lifelong Guidance Policies ELGPN Concept

This is an independent concept paper commissioned by the European Lifelong Guidance Policy Network (ELGPN), a Member-State-network in receipt of EU financial support under the Lifelong Learning Programme. The paper draws from discussions within the Network. This Concept Note is designed to provide policy- makers and stakeholders across Europe with an understanding of the key concepts underpinning the relationship between work-based learning and lifelong guidance. The note suggests that lifelong guidance policies reinforce policy goals for work- based learning. Quality lifelong guidance practices support positive work-based learning experiences and contribute to the fulfilment of the different skills agendas of the European Union.

<u>Towards a European quality framework for apprenticeships and work-based learning</u>
