2. TOOLS FOR WBL FROM SELECTED EU FUNDED PROJECTS

2.1 Università degli studi di Modena e Reggio Emilia – EuroDuaLe project

EuroDuale project - European Cooperative Framework for Dual Learning

EuroDuaLE is an Erasmus+ Project, involving 13 organisations in 6 different EU Member States. The goal of EuroDuaLE is to develop an integrated transnational Dual Learning framework, where Higher Education Institutions and relevant stakeholders in the labour market establish a synergy and provide students with new curricula, combining formal training and training on-the job, physical and virtual mobility. SWORD project - School and work related Dual Learning
